Wauwatosa Public Library Posting and Distribution Policy

The Wauwatosa Public Library, established and supported by the citizens of Wauwatosa, provides access to the facilities, resources and services necessary to meet the informational, educational and leisure needs of all people in the community. It is not one of the library's primary responsibilities to serve as a general distribution point for fliers, pamphlets, tabloids, etc. Space on the bulletin boards and flier distribution racks is limited. Therefore, priority will be given to the following types of materials:

1. Library news and information
2. Information and notices requiring posting by law and other materials issued by governmental agencies and/or departments; local, state or federal
3. Materials selected by the library staff of a cultural, educational, recreational and charitable nature that serve the needs and interests of the Wauwatosa community and conform with the library's materials selection policy.

Due to space limitations, the library staff reserves the right to refuse to post and/or distribute any materials.

The library staff shall decide on the location and arrangement of materials and make an effort to post and/or distribute them in a timely manner.

The posting and/or distribution of materials does not imply endorsement by the library.

Distribution of fliers, pamphlets, etc. by individuals directly to patrons and solicitation and/or petitioning of any kind is expressly prohibited in the library.
